

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Event Format

The Summer of Golf will be played as follows:

Wednesday 5th February

18-holes stableford and 2Ball Aggregate in conjunction.

Ties: All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

Thursday 6th February

18-holes stableford (Veterans), 18-holes stableford (Tradies).

Ties: All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

Friday 7th February

18-holes stableford (both Professionals and amateurs).

Ties: In the event of a tie for the professional event, the winner will be determined by a play-off immediately following the return of the last scorecards. The playoff will be sudden-death on the 18th hole until a winner is determined. All other ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

Saturday 8th and Sunday 9th February

36-holes 4 person Ambrose, 18-holes each day.

Ties: All ties, including 36-hole events, shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

2. Summer of Golf Committee

- The SOG Committee will comprise of the Highlands Golf Club Match Committee, and Head Professionals, and their appointees.
- In the absence of a full SOG Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full SOG Committee.

3. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with the Highlands Golf Club local rules and any additional local rules as drawn up by the Summer of Golf Committee.

4. Entries

- **GA Handicap:** Eligible players are amateurs whose GA Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 36.4 strokes (Male) and 45.4 strokes (Female) at the time of entry.
NOTE: Saturday/Sunday Ambrose Handicap Limits - only one player per team with a GA handicap of 6.0 or less as of Wednesday 5th February 2019. The Maximum team handicap is 10, teams with a combined handicap of more than 10, will play off 10.
- **Age:** Veterans event on Thursday 6th February players must be 55 years of age (Male) or 50 years of age (Female) by 7 February 2019. For all other events, there is no age restriction.
- **Entry Fee:** the entry fee applicable for this event is as advertised on the registration form.
- **Ballot:** In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the event, precedence will be given in order of receipt of entry. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.
- **Player Substitution:** If a registered team of four is unable to fill their fourth position due to withdrawal on one of the rounds, one substitute may be used on the 2nd day of play but must be the same gender as the original player. The team handicap may decrease but not increase. The team will be eligible for the daily event only.

5. Prizes

Competitors/Teams may win only one major prize (excluding NTP, long drives etc.). Prizes will be awarded in order based on value. If two prizes are of the same value, the scratch prize will take precedent.
